## Integrating Sleep Prosthodontics: Breathing Life Into Your Practice

### Dr. Jeffrey Rouse

This course is designed as a follow up to Sleep Prosthodontics for those groups who have hosted Dr. Rouse previously. It can be a perfect staff educational event. Your society will continue to expand their knowledge of Sleep Prosthodontics with a spotlight on incorporating the concepts into a restorative practice. Hands-on and demonstrative exercises are available and will be incorporated into the course outline.

The future of dentistry is the concept of Airway and the 21st century practitioner must be forward thinking in not only the various types of mandibular advancement appliances (MAA), but also Why the complementing technology of pulse oximetry is integral in patient detection of sleep-disordered breathing and its impact on dentistry. This lecture will present the key features of many of the popular designs of MAA, discussing the advantages and disadvantages that will yield in an Appliance Algorithm. Further still, presenting why high-resolution pulse oximetry and cardio-pulmonary coupling in both diagnosis and titration will be reinforced by actual data from a sample of the course participants. Dental Sleep Medicine is no longer simply trending, it is a part of our daily regimen, personally and professionally. Join Dr. Rouse in an engaging discussion and lecture, explicating the myriad of issues that are all connected to Airway, past, present, and future.

*Jeffrey S. Rouse, D.D.S. maintains a full-time private practice and is a Clinical Adjunct Associate Professor in the Department of Prosthodontics at the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio. After graduation from dental school in San Antonio, Dr. Rouse completed a 2-year General Practice Residency at the University of Connecticut Health Science Center. He practiced family dentistry for twelve years before returning to school. Dr. Rouse received his specialty certificate in Prosthodontics from the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio in 2004. He is a member of the American Academy of Restorative Dentistry, the American College of Prosthodontists, past president of the Southwest Academy of Restorative Dentistry and the Excellence in Restorative Dental Education "Los Guapos" Seattle Study Club.*

*Dr. Rouse has written numerous journal articles including the "Annual Review of Selected Dental Literature" published each summer in the Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry. Moreover, he has contributed chapters on porcelain veneers and anterior ceramic crowns to a dental textbook. Dr. Rouse lectures nationally and internationally on a wide variety of topics ranging from dental esthetics to complete dentures. Most recently, Dr. Rouse was appointed as a 2012 keynote speaker for the British Academy of Aesthetic Dentistry (BAAD), London, England, and as a 2012 adjunct faculty of the John Kois Center, teaching exclusively on Sleep Prosthodontics and the treatment of sleep-disturbed breathing. He has been named as a 2013 keynote and plenary session presenter for the 20th annual Seattle Study Club Symposium, Naples, Florida.*

*He is married to Dr. Lisa Rouse, a general and family dentist with whom he practices at Rouse Signature Dentistry. They reside in San Antonio, Texas.*

Dr. Quinonez earned her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Psychology/ Zoology in 1992 and her Doctorate of Medical Dentistry in 1996 from the University of Manitoba. She earned her certificate in Pediatric Dentistry, Master's of Science, and Masters in Public Health Policy and Administration at the UNC at Chapel Hill. Her academic and research interest include the interphase between medicine and dentistry, prenatal and infant oral health, and economic analyses related to children's oral health. Dr. Quinonez returned to full-time academics in 2006 and is currently the Director of the Pediatric Dentistry Pre-Doctoral Program, the Baby Oral Health Program and the Pediatric Dental Faculty Practice at the UNC at Chapel Hill.

## **Can We Do More? Integrating Prenatal and Early Childhood Oral Health into Practice**

I believe that oral health is the window to the entire body and that every child is worthy of an opportunity to benefit from contemporary knowledge and measures that will improve their life span and overall health. Early evaluation, delivery of preventive oral health services and education are key. My teaching philosophy has focused on bridging this gap in dental education, clinical dentistry and medicine by aiming to inspire student and providers to care for young children. The development to the Baby Oral Health Program (bOHP) is an example of achieving this goal. Equally important has been my continued efforts to provide students with strategies and life-long learning skills that will foster their inquisitive nature, and the development of skill sets to become evidence-based and ethical decision makers in clinical practice while appreciating the long-lasting impact they can have on a child.

My more recent collaborations with the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology on the development of the Prenatal Oral Health Program (pOHP) further exemplifies these goals by focusing on working further upstream in the prevention of oral disease by focusing on the mother in addition to the child to break the cycle of poor oral health.

This lecture will provide an update on prenatal and early childhood oral health. It will describe the latest evidence and rationale for beginning early oral health practices with an emphasis on prenatal care and the connection to the infant.

The Prenatal (pOHP) and Baby Oral Health Programs (bOHP), developed at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, will be introduced with a focus on anticipatory guidance messaging and its implementation into clinical practice. The course will conclude with a review of broader initiatives to address early childhood oral health, including the role of partnering with medical colleagues to address oral health disparities.
