Additionally, nutritional supplements have been shown through scientific investigation to benefit oral and overall health. All members of the health care team should be familiar with the evidence of safety and benefit for the most commonly used dietary supplements to enhance patient outcomes and reduce the risk of adverse events associated with dental procedures. This informative and fact-filled lecture will explore how macronutrients, micronutrients, glycemic index/load, dietary patterns, and sugar substitutes impact oral health, periodontal disease, and overall health. Learn the cutting-edge science behind the recommendations.

Participants will be able to describe the key components of a heart-healthy diet.

Participants will be able to counsel patients about sugar and sugar substitutes.

Participants will be able to describe sources of dietary mercury and how to reduce exposure.
